

Rules for Visiting Societies

Visitors are more than welcome at Moor Hall Golf Club but in order to enjoy the Club's facilities to a maximum the following requirements should be strictly enforced by the visiting Society Organiser.

Administration

1. Golf and catering packages are available on request.
2. Organisers are requested to submit to this office, at least 14 days in advance of the event, the number playing on the day together with choice of menu. Final numbers will be required 3 working days prior to the visit (this does not include weekends), which will form the basis of charges.

Tees

1. All members of the visiting Society must start from the 1st tee, unless notified to the contrary by the Secretary or Professional.
2. Yellow markers are to be used.
3. Organisers are to ensure that the times allocated on the start list are strictly adhered to.

The Professional will when possible provide a starter for all matches.

The following guide should be used when making out starting lists:

- a. 4 ball matches 8 minute intervals
- b. 3 ball matches 6 minute intervals
- c. Greensomes & Foursomes 6 minute intervals

Visiting Societies have no priority either before or after the times stated.

Handicaps

To speed up play and to enable better care of the course it is necessary for Organisers to ensure that players have an official golf handicap, evidence of which may be required.

Green Fees

Green fees may be paid in cash or by cheque or major credit cards. Payment is to be made in the Professional's shop ensuring that full details are entered in ink in the Green Fees Book. If a pro forma invoice is required details are to be given to the Secretary.

Catering

All catering and bar requirements are to be arranged with Caterers and Bar Manager direct on 0121-308 0103 at least 14 days in advance.

Professional

It is customary to buy prizes from the Professional's shop which is fully stocked with suitable items.

Prizes

The attention of Organisers is drawn to the limits of value of prizes laid down by the R&A which safeguards Amateur status. Guidance can be given by the Hon. Secretary.

Banners and Flags

Banners are permitted with prior authorization from the Hon. Secretary. Flags are not permitted under any circumstances.
